Other Concerns:

- A concern was raised about a piano that was reportedly donated for community use but is no longer easily accessible. Members discussed looking into the history and current use of the piano and whether community groups should be able to access it without additional barriers.
- There was discussion about swim club requests for more pool time and priority access. It was noted that City programming, swimming lessons, and public swim times remain priorities. Director DeNeire discussed that the club may need to use available times such as mornings or weekends and that bookings should end at the scheduled time.
- Concerns were raised about the aquatic centre doors being opened during swimming lessons, causing the pool area to feel colder. Staff noted they would look into temperature and ventilation concerns.
